From the President

Dear Colleagues,

Elections will be held during the business meeting at the XIX World Congress of Sociology to be held in Toronto, Ontario, Canada on Wednesday, 18 July from 19:30-2:50. I want to encourage all RC04 members who will be attending the World Congress to attend the meeting and vote for the candidates for the 2018-2022 RC04 Board. The nominations committee, composed of Professors Maria Ligia Barbosa of Brazil and Jason Chang of Taiwan reported out the slate of candidates with one candidate for each position and two for the position of Vice Present for Asia. Even with most candidates running unopposed it is essential that members vote, as a candidate receiving no votes cannot serve. We shall also accept nominations from the floor during the business meeting. Our statutes term limit three of the current board members, while one is a candidate for a new position. Professors Barbosa and Chang, as well as Dr. Shaheeda Essack of South Africa who currently is Vice President for Africa, are term limited in their current offices.

The candidates for board positions include:

Marios Vryonides of Cyprus, currently Secretary/Treasurer and Newsletter Editor, for President

Shaheeda Essack of South Africa, currently VP for Africa, for Secretary/Treasurer and Newsletter Editor

The following are eligible to serve one final term if elected:

Carol Reid of Australia, for re-election as VP for Oceania

Kari Kantasalmi of Finland, for re-election as VP for Europe

Svetlana Sharonova of Russia, for re-election as VP for Russia

Walter Allen of the USA, for re-election as VP for North America

The following are eligible to serve two terms if elected:

Analia Meo of Argentina, VP for Latin America

Shinichi Aizawa of Japan, VP for Asia or

Tien-Hui Chaing of Taiwan, VP for Asia

This will be my last letter to you as president of RC04. While the statutes permit the president to serve three terms and I have served two, I think that it is time for a change. I have held office in RC04 for 18 years, serving first as membership chair, then as secretary/treasurer and Newsletter editor, and finally twice as president. One of my goals was to increase membership in RC04 and that has been achieved thanks to the hard work of Marios and the board. Another goal was to provide mid-term conferences in locations around the world so that members would be able to attend a conference without substantial travel. During this time we have had conferences in Cyprus, the Czech Republic, Italy, the USA, Taiwan, Mexico, and have linked up with the national sociological
