

A colloquium namely 'Corps, identité et societé: Autour David Le Breton' took place at the University of Strasbourg, France from 7th to 9th September, 2022. It was a special moment to bring together translators, editor and researchers from around the world who worked under Le Breton's supervision and thus celebrate his academic life. François Laplatine and Georges Vigarello were some of the authors present who, like Le Breton, have a strong influence on world sociology.

Le Breton is internationally recognized as an author of the sociology of the body. He has more than 40 publications such as Sociology of the Body, Anthropology of the Body, Anthropology of Sens, Anthropology of the Pain, The Face and the most recently book, is The Smile. The author has already been translated into the following languages: Portuguese, Spanish, Italian, English and will soon have a translation into Dutch.
