The Y-th School of Young Researchers "Sociology and Society: Social Inequality and Social Justice" has been held on the 16-th- 18-th of October in the Ural Federal University in the framework of the 5-th Russian Congress of sociologists (Yekaterinburg, Russia).

35 master-students and post-graduate students took part in the work of this school.
