Call for Sessions

Professions, Power and (In)justice

Power and Justice have been central themes on the study of professions. Contemporary social, economic and political change, clearly challenge and enhance their relevance. Across the globe, professional work has been effected by broader social forces. New forms of professionalism have been associated to the influence of these current trends, translated in ambivalences of reducing/expanding professional power. At the same time, new arrangements of weakening/strengthening inequalities by professions are yet not clearly understood.

ISA RC52 members are invited to submit SESSION proposals that address these topics in all areas of the professions either in comparative perspective or in one dimension. We also welcome proposals for joint sessions with other RCs and/or Groups.

Decision on the final selection of sessions will be made by the ISA RC52 Executive Board during March 2017. The selected Call for Papers will be launched in April 2017 and abstracts invited for submission via the ISA online system.

Session organizers must be ISA RC52 members and will be responsible for overseeing the selection of papers that would make up the session while recruiting a session chair, when necessary.
