#### Call for papers

The aim of the Congress is discussion and finding the possible paths of overcoming the social tension as the aftermath of the deep social inequality in Ukraine. The new forms of social inequality appear in unequal access of the Ukrainians to such social resources as qualitative secondary and high education, employment, decent pay and pension, qualitative health services and recreation, own business, political participation, authority, internet access, cultural recourses, particularly language competence etc. How do different citizens percept the various kinds of social inequality? The inaccessibility to what resources can provoke the active mass protests and conflicts between different social groups and the public authorities? What the public authorities and civic society should do for reducing the social tension in Ukrainian society? What answers on these questions can be proposed by Sociology? All these questions indicate the scientific issues for consideration at the Congress.

#### Annex 3. REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACT

Length 5000-7000 characters.

Times New Roman, 12 font size, 1,5 space; all print margins are 2 cm.

The title of a session for presentation should be placed on the first line;

the next line should consist the paper (presentation) title;

The author's name, surname, title, affiliation and contacts should be placed on the third line.

Please, pay attention in the abstract to

- The research question;
- Research design and methodology;
- The main research findings and conclusions which will be grounded in the paper.

#### Annex 4. REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTICLES (FULL TEXT PAPER)

- 1. UDC (Universal Decimal Classification) code before the title.
- 2. Article title (in big letters).
- 3. Author's name and surname.
- 4. Author's position and affiliation.
- 5. Abstract in English and Ukrainian (or Russian) (15 lines length).
- 6. Key words (in English and Ukrainian or Russian).
- 7. Main body of the article (including tables and graphs).
- 8. References.
- 8. The article should be supplemented with information about the author(s): the first and last names, title, institutional affiliation, membership in Sociological association of Ukraine or other national associations, the mailing address, contact phones and e-mail.

#### Printing the article, please, take the following requirements:

- 1. Make diagrams, graphics etc. in *Microsoft Graph* (the attachment to *Microsoft Word*) in black and \or white.
- 2. TimesNewRoman, 12 font size, 1,5 space;
- 3. All print margins are 2 cm.

List of references should be places behind the text body in the order of the citing. The references put in the text after the citing in the square brackets (indicate a number of the source and the cited pages. E.g.: [5, c.18]). The articles are accepted by e-mail as an attached document in format WinWord.

#### The article should consist the following parts:

- 1. Relevance and State of art;
- 2. Research question or task;
- 3. Research methodology, design;
- 4. The main findings and their rationality;
- 5. Conclusions and points for discussion and further research.

Authors are fully responsible for accuracy of the facts and data presented in the article, credibility of analysis and validity of the research findings. Submitting the article the author(s) hereby confirm that during research and preparing materials for publication they adhered to professional ethic requirements including ISA (International Sociological Association) Code of Ethics (http://www.isa-sociology.org/about/isa\_code\_of\_ethics.htm). A materials submitted to the journal can only be published if it has not been published and will not be simultaneously submitted or published elsewhere.
