Sociedad e Infancias is an interdisciplinary review that draws from the premise that children and adolescents are social actors; therefore it emphasizes their rights as citizens and their position in society. It understands childhood as a permanent structural component of every social structure, although their members are constantly renewed and experiment childhood in different ways, bringing about a diversity of lived childhoods and adolescences.

The review aims at promoting scientific knowledge, mainly in Spain, Portugal and Latin America, in line with the new studies on childhood.

The review is intended to academics, researchers and students of any field of the Social Sciences related with childhood, and also to professionals, child organizations, international cooperation organizations and mass media. It is published annually.

Types of works accepted

- **-Papers for the monographic section:** Original theoretical or empirical works on any topic related with the proposal of the review editorial board.
- Papers for the miscellany section: Original theoretical or empirical works on any topic related with childhood and adolescence, and/or the study of children and adolescent lives.
- **-Book reviews**: Evaluations and critical analysis of published works on any of the topics of interest to the review.
- **-Other contributions**: This open section will include different contributions on the developments of the fields of applied research, social intervention, children's rights defence or project evaluation, mainly of those in which children and adolescents have been actively involved.

The monographic section of the first number of the *Revista Sociedad e Infancias* will be devoted to **Diversity in Childhood**. Papers are welcome on any topic that highlights the diverse ways in which different generations of children –both in the past and in the present-live their childhood. Specifically, papers on:

-Childhoods and cities. Childhood and gender. Indigenous childhoods. Childhoods and work. Childhoods and colonialism. Political childhoods. Childhood and consumption. Childhood and social class....

Contributions must be written in Spanish or Portuguese.
