The Department of Political Science, Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut is organizing an International Seminar on **“Vista of Indian Political Thinking : Prospective International Alternative”** in collaboration with the Indian Political Science Association (IPSA) in C.C.S. University, Meerut on 12-13 August, 2017.

Main Theme

The seminar would focus on understanding the dynamics of changing academic paradigm emanating from global failure of Western political thinking in providing solutions to international problems of mankind. We would also solicit researches attempting to provide insights into different dimensions of visible limits of Western thought processes in political arena. This seminar would have central focus on analyzing the Indian intellectual tradition of statecraft (*Rajdharma*) and political thinking in ancient India besides tracing the possibilities of contemporary relevance of these models at global level as an alternative.

By way of explaining various unexplored aspects of Indian political thought in ancient as well as modern era, the present international seminar would provide a platform to different academic discourses prevalent in contemporary political thinking. This international academic event would necessarily become a most sought after discussion table on the nature, profile, characteristics, strengths and weaknesses of political thinking in India. Therefore, the seminar attempts at creating more rigorous endeavours of research and analysis of political thinking in India with a focus on exploring the global relevance as an alternative discourse.

Sub-Themes

The sub themes of the seminar would be as follows:

1. Prevalent Global Streams of Political Thinking.
2. Indian Vision of Political Thinking.
3. Profiling Indian Political Thought.
4. International Alternative Models of Political Thinking.
5. Possibilities of Indian Alternative in Political Thinking.

Call for papers:- Paper proposals in the form of abstracts are invited from interested scholars. Submissions are to be made either in Hindi or English language only. Abstracts typed in MS Word format in Times

New Roman font (12) only and Hindi Kruti Dev font (14) not exceeding 250 words are to be submitted on ipsaseminarmeerut@gmail.com latest by 20th June 2017. The submissions should also include names(s) of the author(s), mailing address, email, contact number and a 50 words resume. Acceptance will be communicated by 30th June, 2017. The full length paper within 5000 words, should positively be submitted before 20th July 2017 to be included in the Special Volume of the Indian Journal of Political Science (IJPS).
