ISA Research Committee on the Sociology of Health and Illness (RC49) is keen to encourage submissions from early career researchers to the forthcoming XIX ISA World Congress of Sociology in Toronto, Canada, July 15-21, 2018. In order to encourage excellent applications by new researchers we are holding a competition to award:

TRAVEL BURSARY for the best abstract for an early career researcher. The travel bursary will cover travel costs and accommodation up to the value of US\$750 (proof will be required that appropriate travel and accommodation has been booked).

In order to be eligible for the competition applicants must:

- be a current Ph.D. student
- have submitted an abstract by September 30, 2017 24.00 GMT to one of the sessions organized by RC49 listed at https://isaconf.confex.com/isaconf/wc2018/webprogrampreliminary/Symposium486.html
- be registered as a member of RC49 through ISA membership platform http://www.isa-sociology.org/en/membership/individual-membership/
- those who already hold a position as an academic at a University or teaching establishment are not eligible

Submitted abstracts will be judged by members of the RC49 board on the basis of their academic rigor and originality. We particularly encourage abstracts which demonstrate originality in terms of theory, research methods or collaboration with users of mental health services. The decision of the judges will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
