CANDIDATES FOR THE ISA OFFICERS for the period Fall 2018 - Summer 2022

Submission deadline: two days before the scheduled election at the XIX ISA World Congress of Sociology, Toronto, Canada, July 2018

Nominations from the floor must be supported by **five members** present and made with the consent of the candidate.

- at least one proposers of the candidate for the Research Council section of Executive Committee must be a Delegate to the Research Council;
- at least one proposers of the candidate for the National Associations section of Executive Committee must be a Delegate to the Council of National Associations:

All proposers must be either individual ISA members in good standing, or delegates to the Council of National Associations from associations in good standing.

All candidates other than those for the National Associations section must have been ISA individual members in good standing since the previous World Congress and must still be so at the time of elections. After two consecutive terms on the Executive Committee no member is eligible for a further consecutive term, except as President.

A duly signed nomination form should be received at the ISA stand at the Congress registration area at least **two days before** the scheduled election.

For the candidates for the President and Vice-Presidents it should also include their priorities (maximum 500 words) if elected to a post.
