The Nationalism Studies Program, an interdisciplinary program at Central European University (CEU), invites applications for a full-time Assistant Professor position in Nationalism and Social Psychology.

The Nationalism Studies Program was established at Central European University with the aim of engaging students in an empirical and theoretical study of issues of nationalism, migration, self-determination, state-formation, ethnic conflict, minority protection and the related theme of globalization. Drawing upon the uniquely supranational milieu of Central European University, the program encourages a critical and non-sectarian study of nationalism.

Duties and responsibilities:

The candidate would be expected to teach BA, MA and PhD courses in the following areas:

- nationalism and ethnic/racial prejudice
- theories of nationalism
- intergroup relations (sociological and psychological approaches)
- social research methodologies (quantitative and qualitative approaches)
- migration and refugee studies

In addition to teaching, the successful candidate will supervise MA theses and PhD dissertations.

Qualifications:

- Specializing in the study of prejudice and interethnic relations.
- PhD in Sociology or a related field.
- Experience in empirical research (quantitative and qualitative).
- Proficiency in at least one Central European language.
- Teaching experience at the university level.
- Proven ability to secure research grants.

Compensation

We offer a competitive yearly salary of EUR 60,000, commensurate with experience as well as additional benefits (e.g. pension plan). The initial contract is for 6 years. Contracts are renewable and can be turned into indefinite contracts depending on outcome of review.

Applicants need to submit:

- A comprehensive CV.
- Three reference letters (candidates should ask their referees to send recommendations directly to CEU).
- List of publications.
- Two sample publications.

- A statement of research and teaching (including 2 course outlines).
