Guidelines for applying for Ad Hoc Sessions

Application for Ad Hoc Session should include:

- Title of the session
- Name(s) and full mailing address of the organiser(s)
- Short description of the session contents
- List of potential contributors

In order to qualify for a place in the Congress programme, the potential session must involve:

- Substantial number of sociologists;
- From several countries:
- Who have already engaged in some collaboration, and
- Whose special interest does not properly fit within the field of and within the field of an established ISA Research Committee, Working or Thematic Group

One session will be allocated to each Ad Hoc and they will be held at 17:30-19:20 during 5 days, Monday through Friday, July 24-30, 2022

There is a limited number of slots (5) for Ad Hoc Sessions in the Congress programme, and therefore applications will be evaluated by the ISA Programme Committee on their strength on the competitive basis.

The applications should be received at the ISA Secretariat in Madrid <u>isa@isa-sociology.org</u> by May 10, 2022.

The selection of a maximum of 5 proposals will be done in late May 2022 by the Program Committee.
