Guidelines for applying for integrative sessions by Research Committees and National Associations

Integrative Sessions connect around a debate on a common theme:

- at least three Research Committees, Working Groups, Thematic Groups
- at least three National Associations (ISA collective members)
- or a combination of any three units

Proposals for integrative sessions should indicate

- the name of each of the participating units
- the name and e-mail of the contact person from each unit
- the name and e-mail of the proposal coordinator

It should also provide, in maximum 250 words, a description of:

- the problematic which will be addressed
- how the participating units will contribute to an integrative reflection about the topic
- the names of the proposed speakers and their themes

Proposals need to be authorised/signed by President of each participating unit.

No more than two submissions should be made by the same RC/WG/TG or Association.

RC/WG/TG participation in an integrative session is in addition to the regular sessions' allocation.

Integrative Sessions will be held at 12:30-14:00 during 5 days, Monday through Friday, June 26-30, 2023.

The deadline for submitting proposals is **May 10, 2022**.

The selection of a maximum of 10 proposals will be done in late May 2022 by a sub-committee composed of the four members of the Executive Committee who sit on the Research Coordinating Committee as well as on the National Associations Liaison Committee, plus the Vice President, National Associations and the Vice President, Research.
