


In this issue you will find news of upcoming events. And as always, don't hesitate to let us know if you have any ideas, events or publications you'd like to share in future issues of WoW!


De tal modo, se consideran **debates epistemológicos, teóricos y metodológicos, así como resultados de procesos de investigación en curso o recientemente finalizados**. Se espera que los/as expositores/as de los simposios desarrollen una discusión actualizada e informada, y faciliten comparaciones a partir de su experiencia investigativa. Al mismo tiempo, estarán en condiciones de **proponer líneas de investigación** y acciones tendientes a estimular los estudios del trabajo, así como el diálogo entre diferentes disciplinas y generaciones de investigadores/as.

De la misma manera, los Simposios pueden ser espacios dirigidos a desarrollar la reflexión de **problemáticas más específicas** (institucionales, acceso a redes de colaboración, agendas investigativas, entre otras) a nivel regional, subregional o nacional, entendiendo que en este caso el Simposio espera contribuir a estimular y **fortalecer las comunidades de investigación latinoamericanas**.

XX ISA WORLD CONGRESS OF SOCIOLOGY

RESURGENT AUTHORITARIANISM: THE SOCIOLOGY OF NEW ENTANGLEMENTS OF RELIGIONS, POLITICS, AND ECONOMIES

MELBOURNE, JUNE 25-JULY 1, 2023


Since the last ISA forum on February, ISA presidents and delegates have met several times to make an assessment of ISA events.

During the first **two meetings (on March 6th and April 10th)** between RC presidents, we discussed about the different ways of holding our forum and congresses, and about the advantages and disadvantages of online/in-person experiences. We have intended to take advantage of our experience of the last Porto Alegre forum, and make our best to figure out some ways **to improve two main topics: membership inclusiveness and equalities, and democracy and consultation in our sociological association.** We spent more than five hours each Saturday (morning, evening, night depending the time zone...), for an incredible, rich and vigorous discussion.

In June, we had our third meeting, which included a broader participation: it was an ISA Assembly of councils animated by our ISA President (Sari Hanafi) and including as well the Executive council, national associations' councils, RC presidents, RC delegates...

It was an extraordinary instance to keep on discussing, and to make the difficult decision about the date of the next World congress in this pandemic context. After some hours, and taking in consideration previous discussions, results from ISA survey and scientific, social, human and financial arguments, **we eventually voted by a large majority to postpone the next ISA World congress to june-july 2023.**

A second deliberation and vote were made in order to extend the Executive council mandate (with probably an extension of RC mandates), to manage this challenge.

ZANI, BEATRICE. 2021. WOMEN MIGRANTS IN SOUTHERN CHINA AND IN TAIWAN. MOBILITIES, DIGITAL ECONOMIES AND EMOTIONS. ABINGTON AND NEW YORK: ROUTLEDGE

Hidden inside a suitcase, invisible to border controls, an orange, fluorescent bra made in a textile factory in Southern China crosses the Strait and arrives to Taiwan. There, it wanders and circulates, on translocal physical and digital circuits, and it moves back to its place of fabrication in China. Based on multi-sited ethnographic research in China and Taiwan, including over one hundred interviews, this book follows the social life of a bra and explores the mobilities of its producers: Chinese women who move from the countryside to the city, their marriage-migration to Taiwan and, eventually, re-migration to China post-divorce. With close attention to the link between migration, emotion, and ICT, the author considers the development of digital social networks, solidarity practices, and e-entrepreneurship by women to undo a condition of subalternity along their multiple mobilities. It elucidates the complex morphology of contemporary mobility, shaped by ever-changing processes of local territorialisation and global connectedness. Following both women and the objects that they commercialise, as well as the emotions that they construct, this volume examines the making of novel digital, commercial, and emotional geographies of interconnection between China and Taiwan, and the multiple forms that globalisation can take.

Beatrice Zani is a sociologist, postdoctoral research fellow at McGill University, Department of East-Asian studies. She is research associate at the European Research Centre on Contemporary Taiwan (ERCCT, Tuebingen University), and at TRIANGLE (ENS Lyon, France). She is also executive board member of the European Association of Taiwan Studies (EATS) and of the network 'Migration' of the French Sociological Association (AFS). Her ongoing research focuses migrant e-entrepreneurs' the digitalised and transnational trade which connects Taiwan to China and South-East to elucidate the link between migration, emotion and ICT in the making of capitalism and globalisation. Her work has been recently awarded: the Mobility Prize by the Forum Mobile Lives; the Lyon 2 University Dissertation Award, and the Young Author Award by the journal *Sociology of Work*. She has recently published (selection): 'Shall WeChat? Switching between online and offline ethnography' (*Bulletin of Sociological Methodology*, 2021); 'Digital Entrepreneurship. E-commerce among Chinese Marriage-Migrant Women in Taiwan' (*Journal of Chinese Overseas*, 2021).

Ce sont à la fois les sociologies du berceau européen des sciences sociales avec l'**Allemagne**, le **Royaume-Uni**, l'**Italie** – l'**Espagne** est un peu à part avec la période franquiste – et celle des **États-Unis**. Le Corpus traite aussi de pays souvent désignés comme « émergents » tels que le **Mexique**, l'**Argentine** et la **Chine**. Les articles sont tous, à leur manière, analytiques et critiques des transformations des objets de recherche, des problématiques naissantes ou disparues, des paradigmes dominants ou de ceux qui s'effacent. Ils montrent aussi les convergences, les circulations intellectuelles et les différences entre toutes ces sociologies. Sans oublier les effets des transformations du capitalisme sur ces sociologies...


