ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- A PhD from the Social Sciences or Education
- Open to South Africans and foreign nationals available for full-time research at the University of Fort Hare
- Preference to be given to women, South African citizens and South African permanent residents
- Evidence of previous publications in DHET-accredited journals or book chapters
- Completion of PhD degree within the last five years
- Successful applicant required to relocate to the Alice Campus of the University of Fort Hare immediately

THE SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

- Utilize quantitative and qualitative research methods to conduct scholarly and publishable research
- Publish a minimum of three (3) scholarly outputs in DHET-accredited journals or books
- Take part in research workshops, seminars and conferences within the university, nationally and internationally

THE VALUE OF THE POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP:

- The postdoctoral fellowship is valued at R300 000-00 per annum (non-taxable)
- While valid for ONE year, it is however renewable for a second year on condition of satisfactory performance and/or availability of funds
