Building on our strengths in Social Inequality, Population Dynamics, and Quantitative Methods, the Department of Sociology at Western University (www.sociology.uwo.ca) invites applications for a three-year limited-term faculty position at the rank of Assistant Professor, effective July 1, 2023 or as negotiated.

The Department is seeking a talented scholar with expertise in: Health and Families. Preference will be given to those who can teach courses on the Sociology of Health and Illness, Health Inequality, Drugs and Society, Family and Work, Inequalities Across Families, Issues Facing Modern Families, or Society and You which is an introductory course. Preference will also be given to those with demonstrated knowledge and expertise in applied research, research methods, and research design.

To be considered for this appointment, applicants must have a PhD in Sociology or a related discipline completed by the start date of the appointment. Responsibilities will include teaching the equivalent of six half-year courses at the undergraduate level. Participation in graduate examinations and service to the Department and the Faculty are also required. With the growing diversity of our student body, it is expected that the successful candidate will effectively demonstrate an ability to contribute to an inclusive learning environment for our students. They should also provide evidence of research and teaching excellence and the candidate must also demonstrate the ability to teach effectively at the undergraduate level and have excellent oral and written communication skills. The candidate should also demonstrate the ability to collaborate and contribute to the department's teaching and service in a collegial manner.

Western University is a top-ranked research-intensive university located in London, Ontario which is two hours from Toronto and Detroit. Situated in the Faculty of Social Science, the Department of Sociology offers full programs for undergraduate, MA, and PhD students.
