Membership Types and Benefits

RC43 offers several ways to be involved:

- Regular members register through the ISA account portal and pay
 membership fees to both RC43 and ISA. They enjoy the full range of benefits,
 including eligibility for ISA and RC43 grants, voting rights at RC43 Business
 Meetings and elections, and the chance to stand for election as Officers or
 Board Members.

ISA - RC43 Membership

RC43 Only Affiliated members pay fees only to RC43, and their registration is managed directly by RC43. While they can access RC43 grants (for RC43-only events) and vote at Business Meetings, they cannot stand for election as Officers or Board Members. Please note that the registration system for affiliated members is currently being updated. We therefore recommend registering as a regular member to access to all opportunities.
