

## Note about RC36 Sessions in Rabat 2025

Our week-long series of sessions will explore Alienation in various contemporary and theoretical contexts. It will reflect the interdisciplinary sociological concerns related to anthropology, education, and political economy. After all, Sociology is never alone. There is no singleness or only-oneness in what is social. The sessions comprehensively address:

- **Theoretical Foundations:** The conference opens with "Estudios De La Alienación: Teoría y Método," laying a foundation on alienation theory and research methods.
- **Embodiment and Emotion:** Sessions such as "Sports, Bodies, and Emotions" and the three-part series on "The Affective and Emotional Dimensions of Alienation" focus on how emotions and physicality intertwine with alienation processes in modern societies.
- **Technology and Digital Life:** "Digital Alienation" examines internet and AI's roles in shaping alienation in everyday life, reflecting the growing importance of digital sociology.
- **Environmental and Human Development Perspectives:** The "Anthropocene" themed sessions analyze alienation in the context of environmental crises and human development paradigms.
- **Social Justice and Political Economy:** Sessions like "Alienation, Racial Capitalism, and Palestine" provide critical perspectives linking alienation to systemic inequalities.
- **Education and Labour Market:** The two sessions on higher education systems investigate the tensions between quality assurance, rankings, and alienation in relation to employment markets.
- **Future-Oriented Research:** Closing with "Alienation and Futures Research," the conference projects forward-looking perspectives on alienation studies and methodologies.



This comprehensive program offers an engaging platform for academics, practitioners, and students to explore the multifaceted dimensions of alienation in modern societies, encouraging interdisciplinary dialogue and forward-thinking research.


