Worldwide, children and adolescents represent per se a vulnerable social and population group. This is due to their physical constitution (weaker, smaller), their short-lived experience, and their social position of dependence and lack of power. Although this vulnerability is apparently inherent to childhood and adolescence, other vulnerabilities produced by the circumstances that characterize the complexity of contemporary societies intersect it. Some of the most important are the migration flows, the economic crisis, the lack of care -or the helplessness that face those who should provide it-, the scarcity or low coverage of the actions of the State's social policies -such as education or social security-, the wars, and the environmental threats. Nevertheless, although their personal constraints and the adverse circumstances, childhood research has proved that, under certain conditions, children's and adolescents' abilities can transform their vulnerability into strength.

The review Sociedad e infancias calls researchers, educators, teachers and other professionals to send their contributions on children's and adolescent's agency, in social contexts and circumstances characterized by risks that make them more vulnerable.

Types of works accepted:

- Papers for the monographic section: Original theoretical or empirical works on any topic related with the subject of the Childhood protagonism in contexts of de vulnerability.
- <u>Papers for the miscellany section</u>: Original theoretical or empirical works on any topic related with childhood and adolescence, and/or with the study of children and adolescent lives.
- <u>Book reviews</u>: Evaluations and critical analysis of published works on any of the topics of interest to the review.
- Other contributions: This open section will include different contributions on the developments of the fields of applied research, social intervention, children's rights defence or project evaluation, mainly of those in which children and adolescents have been actively involved.

All submitted papers must be written in Spanish or Portuguese.
