We welcome teachers, graduate students, undergraduates of Russian and foreign educational and scientific organizations, scholars, specialists focusing on urban studies, representatives of public and municipal authorities and other interested persons.

### **Conference deadlines:**

1. September 20, 2019 — deadline for submitting an application for participation. Applications should be sent electronically to the e-mail address: [conf2019@isi-rb.ru](mailto:conf2019@isi-rb.ru) (as MS Word or RTF files) formatted according to Appendix 1
2. October 1, 2019 – deadline for full-text submission. Articles should be formatted according to the requirements after verification for plagiarism
3. October 10, 2019 – posting the conference programme on the website [isi-rb.ru](http://isi-rb.ru)
4. October 23, 2019 – arrival of participants
5. October 24, 2019 – registration of conference participants, plenary and breakout sessions
6. October 25, 2019 – registration of workshop participants; workshop organization
7. October 26, 2019 – departure of participants

### **GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS:**

The title of the application file should include the surname of the first author and the word “application”, for example, “Ivanov application”.

The title of the article file should include the surname of the first author and the word “article”, for example, “Ivanov article”.

The volume of the article is up to five A4 pages, with 20-mm margins on each side, without pagination. Materials must be formatted in MS Word, Times New Roman, font size – 14 pt, paragraph indentation – 1.25 cm, 1.5 spacing. Table design: font size – 12 pt, single spacing.

The reference list should be formatted according to GOST R. 7.05–2008. Self-citations should not exceed 30 percent. Footnotes in the text are given in square brackets; their enumeration should correspond to the reference list placed at the end of the article in alphabetical order.

The structure of the main file containing the text of the article (Appendix 2):

- UDC (in the upper left corner);
- title of the article in the Russian and English languages centered and capitalized, with no indent and point,
- information about the authors (on the right): full name, academic degree, rank, position, affiliation, city, country;
- empty line;
- abstract of the article in the Russian and English languages (250-500 signs);
- key words in the Russian and English languages (4-6 words);
- empty line;
- text;
- empty line;
- reference list in alphabetical order.

All the materials submitted should be checked for originality using the “AntiPlagiarism” software. The article is to be accompanied with a screen file containing the results of the test. The originality of the article shall be not less than 80 percent.

The organising committee is entitled to reject the materials in case they do not correspond to the requirements and subject matter of the conference. The materials can be returned for revision.
