### Volume 5 "TIME IN CHILDHOOD AND ADOLESCENCE"

**Deadline for papers submission: February 15, 2021**

The subject of this monograph is deliberately broad, because it is intended to attract articles that, from different perspectives, address the many ways in which childhood and time intertwine.

Time evokes both continuity and change, and its contemplation is decisive for our understanding of the social spaces of childhood in different times and societies. Time marks personal capacity, responsibility, expectations, connects disjointed events through a notion of linear progress towards greater autonomy, a notion which is well known to girls, boys and adolescents.

Time operates in the daily life of children, which unfolds in family, institutional, public and natural environments. Therefore, time and temporality are of central importance in understanding well-being in childhood and adolescence. Finally, in today's societies characterized by spatio-temporal acceleration, the times and rhythms of society and children may differ. Thus children may feel hurried, "out of time" or in need of gaining some space and time for themselves.

#### Types of works accepted:

- Articles for the monographic section: Original theoretical or empirical works on any topic related with the subject of "TIME IN CHILDHOOD AND ADOLESCENCE".
- Articles for the miscellany section: Original theoretical or empirical works on any topic related with childhood and adolescence, and/or with the study of children and adolescent lives.
- Book reviews: Evaluations and critical analysis of published works on any of the topics of interest to the journal.
- Other contributions: This open section will include different contributions on the developments of the fields of applied research, social intervention, children's rights defence or project evaluation, mainly of those in which children and adolescents have been actively involved.

All submitted papers must be written in **Spanish** or **Portuguese**.
