





Position: Assistant Professor (100% research based)

The Interdisciplinary Centre of Labour Market and Family Dynamics (LABFAM) University of Warsaw is seeking to fill a position of an Assistant Professor (full-/part-time, fixed-term, 100% research based) within the ERC Consolidator Grant "Globalization- and Technology-Driven Labour Market Change and Fertility" (PI: Anna Matysiak).

The ERC Consolidator Grant "Globalisation- and Technology-Driven Labour Market Change and Fertility" aims at investigating fertility consequences of the unprecedented changes which have been taking place in the labour markets over the last decades, such as the rising demand for skills, massive displacement of workers due to automation, spread of new, more flexible but also more fragmented work arrangements, increasing work demands and growing inequalities in labour market prospects between the low-and-medium and the highly skilled. The project started on 1.10.2020 and will last for 5 years. It is conducted at the Interdisciplinary Centre Labour Market and of Family Dynamics (www.labfam.uw.edu.pl) University of Warsaw, which integrates researchers interested in investigating the interdependencies between labour force participation, family life, gender and well-being from an interdisciplinary cross-country perspective.

Requirements:

The candidate should have:

- a PhD in Sociology, Psychology, Demography, Political Science or similar, preferably with a focus on the labour market and / or family research;
- a minimum two years of experience after the PhD, preferably at an internationally recognised research institution;
- research expertise in the field of labour market, family, gender, social inequalities and/or policies, excellent command of related theories and experience in conducting empirical research on the topic at an international level
- excellent track record of publications in peer-reviewed international journals ranked in ICR:
- good command of modern techniques of quantitative data analysis and experience in working with large datasets;
- excellent communication skills;
- fluency in English.

The knowledge of Polish is not required.

The competition is open to persons who meet the requirements set in forth in the Act on Higher Education of July 20, 2018 (consolidated text: Journal of Laws 2020, item 85, as amended)¹

Description of the job:

The successful candidate will:

- Contribute to the development of the theoretical framework of the mechanisms linking the participation in the labour market, family formation, gender and policies from the sociological and psychological perspectives
- Conducting empirical studies on the effects of changing conditions of labour force participation on family formation with the use of quantitative data and methods
- Preparing academic articles
- Disseminating project results
- Supporting the PI in supervising PhD students
- Participating in various LABFAM research activities and events (e.g. seminars and conferences), collaborating with LABFAM researchers.

We offer:

- Employment opportunities till 30.09.2025 subject to an evaluation after the first year. Both full-time and part-time employment is possible.
- Monthly remuneration (100% FTE) depending on qualifications: 13 000 14 000 PLN gross ($^{\sim}$ 2 800 3 100 EUR) + the 13 $^{\circ}$ salary
- Work in the dynamic and interdisciplinary research environment which facilitates scientific exchange and support high quality research (www.labfam.uw.edu.pl)
- The position is available since 1st June 2021 and should be filled as soon as possible.

- Scientific CV including employment history, scientific accomplishments, information about awards, scholarships, research projects and a complete list of publications
- Motivation letter describing previous research and research interests of the candidate and motivating candidate's interest in the position. The motivation letter should also explain how the candidate meets the requirements of the call (up to 5 pages)

- A recommendation letter

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Information on personal data processing

Data Protection Officer (DPO)

The DPO, however, does not proceed other matters, like handling recruitment procedures, collecting recruitment documents, providing information on current recruitment process.

Purpose and legal grounds of data processing

Personal data of candidates for employment shall be processed for recruitment purposes only. Your personal data shall be processed in the scope as indicated by employment law (given name (names) and family name, date of birth, contact information as provided, education, professional qualifications, previous employment) for the purposes of this recruitment process, whereas other data shall be processed based on your consent which may take the following wording:

If your documents include data as mentioned in Art. 9 section 1 of the GDPR (special categories of personal data), processing shall be possible upon your consent to processing such data which may take the following wording:

The University of Warsaw shall be also processing your personal data in future recruitment processes upon your consent which may take the following wording:

I consent to processing of my personal data for the purposes of any future recruitment processes at the University of Warsaw for the period of the next nine months.

Be advised that the revocation of your consent does not affect legal compliance of processing which had been completed upon consent before its revocation.

Data retention period

Your personal data collected in this recruitment process shall be stored over the period of three months from the date the recruitment process is completed. After the end of the recruitment process, the data will be archived.

In case you agree to process your data in future recruitments, your data shall be used over the period of nine months.

Data recipients

Officers authorized by the Controller shall have access to your personal data, the processing of which is in the scope of their duties.

Recipients of personal data may be other subjects obligated by the Controller to provide specific services involving data processing, like

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Data transfer outside the European Economic Area (EEA)

Your personal data shall be disclosed to subjects authorized by law. Signing-in is through Google Forms. Your personal data may be also processed by our provider of G-Suit for education by Google Company in their data processing centres. Your data shall be protected under the standards of the Privacy Shield, accepted by the European Commission. This shall guarantee an adequate level of data security.

Rights of the data subject

Under the GDPR data subjects have the following rights:
